It is really important that **absence request forms** are completed for all holidays etc. If a form isn't received the absence will be shown as "Unauthorised" as opposed to "Holiday Agreed", "Holiday Not Agreed" or "Other Authorised Absence". Also a timely reminder that **school opens** at 8.45am for children to arrive **before 9am** via the classroom doors. Children arriving **between 9am and 9.20am** will enter school through the office entrance and be marked as **Late**, including the number of minutes. If arriving **late after 9.20am** attendance will be shown as an **Unauthorised Absence** unless attending a medical appointment. Can you please inform the office of **medical appointments providing a letter/slip or appointment card** for the file. Thank you for your support.
