




# Henry Chadwick Primary School

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|    | <p><b>Literacy:</b><br/>Following on from our thoroughly enjoyable trip to the theatre in December, we will be studying 'The Wizard of Oz'. We will be looking at the author's use of unique settings and character development. We will focus also on developing our own style of narrative with identifiable characters and allowing children to express themselves through their use of description and vocabulary choices.</p>   |
| <p><b>Numeracy:</b><br/>In Maths we will be focusing on both the arithmetic and reasoning aspects of each sub topic. We will begin with looking at those areas of fractions that we need a little bit more practice with and then swiftly move on to shape, pace and measure. We will encounter lots of different types of tasks and questions types in order to prepare ourselves as well as possible.</p> |   |
|   | <p><b>Science:</b><br/>We will be looking at forces in motion, differentiating between the main forces that affect us daily and looking at how we can investigate those forces from the classroom and beyond. Children will work together to plan and fairly test the use of a force in motion.</p>  |
|    | <p><b>Topic:</b><br/>In our Connected Curriculum theme, we will look at all things to do with London. In Year 5 and 6, we will have a stronger focus on British Values, democracy and the UK Parliament. Apart from this, we will also look strongly at the history, geography and creative side that London has to offer.</p>   |
| <p><b>R.E:</b> This term, we will be focusing on how the major world religions view God and how their beliefs and practices reflect the attributes commonly associated with God in our society.</p>   |   |
|    | <p><b>P.E</b><br/>As well as activities within the Prince William Award, the children will focus on Gymnastics and Invasion Games for the duration of this term. They will put into practice the use of teamwork and how to use different skills as a key to success.</p>  |
