## EARLY YEARS' VISIT TO AMERTON FARM

As part of our topic this term, and as a treat in the lead up to Christmas, we have arranged to visit Amerton Farm, near Stafford. The visit will take place on Monday, 16<sup>th</sup> December 2019. The suggested contribution for the trip is £8.49, which includes entry to the Farm (a tractor and trailer ride to the Winter Enchanted Village, visit to Santa's Grotto to meet Santa, meet Santa's reindeer, playtime in Billy's Farm Barn, a present from Santa and a wooden Christmas decoration to bring home). The coach is being paid for by the PFA to whom we are very grateful for their continued support.

We will leave school by 9.15am, after the register has been taken and the children have had the opportunity to go to the toilet, arriving at the Farm by 10am. Children should wear school uniform (preferably trousers), outdoor footwear and a warm coat, as most of the day will be spent outside; children will need a disposable lunch, snacks and drinks for the day (if anyone would like a packed lunch provided by school please inform the office as soon as possible). We will leave the Farm at 2pm and be back at school for the normal finishing time. The children will need to wear seat belts on the coach but car seats are not required.

If your child isn't normally in school on Mondays (Nursery) there will be no additional charge for wraparound, so usual hours can still be taken during the rest of the week.

The preferred form of payment for this trip is via Parent Pay, where permission is also given as well as emergency contact information is required. Payment should be made by the 1<sup>st</sup> December please. Please do NOT make any payment for this trip onto your child's dinner money account - please use the link provided for the Farm visit. If you are in receipt of Free School Meals the cost of the visit will be subsidised - please see Mrs Jones for a permission letter.

By paying onto Parent Pay for this trip we consider that you are also giving your permission for your child to take part in the visit to Amerton Farm - if you have any additional requirements you wish staff to be aware of please speak to myself, Mrs Simmonds or Miss James.
