Dear Parents / Carers

As you may be aware, the Government produced a set of contingency plans for schools using a tiered system on the 28th August. The Government information is as follows:

Tier 1 involves remaining fully open, as the Government has been clear that ensuring schools and educational settings remain open should be prioritised over other areas when restrictions are considered.

Tier 2 asks secondary schools to adopt a rota system and further education (FE) colleges to limit on-site attendance, whilst all other settings, including alternative provision (AP) and special schools, remain fully open.

Tier 3 requires secondary schools and FE colleges to limit on-site attendance to just vulnerable children and young people, the children of critical workers and selected year groups, other settings remain fully open. In the event of Tier 3 local restrictions being implemented the Department for Education will issue operational guidance for the affected area that will confirm which year groups should be prioritised.


Tier 4 goes further to limit attendance to just vulnerable children and young people and the children of critical workers at all settings, excluding AP and special schools. Where there are no local restrictions in place, education provision should continue to remain fully open to all, and these tiers do not apply.

The tiers will be decided by the Government and are not school decisions.

So how will this look at Henry Chadwick?

You can see from the above information that there are no changes to Primary Provision until Tier 4 is reached. We however will, at Tier 3, ensure that all staff are wearing face coverings - either shields or masks at all times except when teaching at the front of the class or outside 2 metres away from pupils at all times.

At Tier 4, we would revert to only having vulnerable children (those with an EHCP or a social worker) and the children of Keyworkers in school and staffing would be on a rota basis. If this was the case then all children would be sent daily video and/or Power Point lessons and associated work. The expectation would be that all work is returned to school on a daily basis.

Should children have to self-isolate or quarantine, daily work will be sent home as above with the expectation that it is returned daily unless they are too unwell to complete it.

Other contingency plans

If a confirmed case of COVID-19 is reported, we will contact our local 'Public Health England Health Protection Team' (PHE HPT) who will make a decision regarding the next steps. As soon as we have this information, we will inform you of the plans immediately. You will not need to take any further action unless advised to do so by the school or PHE HPT.
