


# Henry Chadwick Primary School

We are looking forward to starting our new topics this term!





### Literacy:

In Literacy we are following texts based on our 'Around the World' Topic. We are beginning with 'Journey' by Aaron Becker, followed by the Usborne Young Readers edition of 'Around the World in 80 days.'

### Numeracy:

In Numeracy we are continuing to focus on place value and calculations work.



### Topic/Science

We are beginning a new Topic-called 'Around the World.' This will focus on Christopher Columbus-who he was, what he achieved and where he visited.

In Science, our next topic is 'Animals Including Humans'.

### R.E and PSHE

In R.E, we are learning about stories from religious texts, focusing on Christianity and Hinduism.
