### Test and Trace

School has agreed to take part in a Quality Assurance two-week trial as part of the continuing work of the NHS to check the efficiency of Lateral Flow testing. Staff who are routinely testing twice weekly with Lateral Flow tests will be asked to conduct a PCR test at the same time; the PCR swabs will be posted to a laboratory for testing to compare against the home LFD results. This is optional and we hope that most staff will take part in this QA exercise for the two weeks to help support the NHS testing process.
