Perfect for KS2

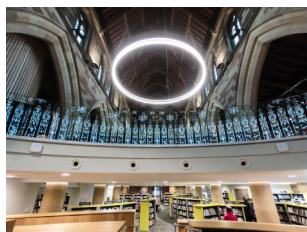
The Boy Who Met a Whale—Nizrana Farook
