What is a food bank?

A food bank is a place that collects tins and packets of food from people who want to share and give, and they hand it out to people who don't have enough to eat.

There are food banks in Rugeley and Lichfield. At our Harvest Assembly next week we are collecting food to donate to a food bank to help others.
