## Y5/6 Visit to the Harry Potter Studio Tour: 2<sup>nd</sup> November 2022

We are delighted to say we have been able to book a school trip linked to the text we are focussing on in class this coming term - Harry Potter.

The trip will cost a total of £47.35 and this will be added to Parent Pay shortly. Permissions and medical details will be collated from Parent Pay. I hope you agree that this is a wonderful opportunity to bring life to the books we are reading and the texts we will be covering in class. For those in receipt of FSM the trip will be subsidised by school - please contact Mrs Jones, if this is the case, to complete a permission form.

The coach will leave school at 8.30am prompt, to ensure that we arrive at Watford in plenty of time for our 12noon slot. If children could be dropped off at school between 8.15am and 8.20am it would be appreciated. The average time for a visit is 3 ½ hours. Arrangements have, therefore, been made for the coach to leave the Warner Brothers Studio at approximately 3.30pm. However, if we are finished earlier or later than this time I will contact the coach driver to make the necessary arrangements. Texts will be sent to parents/carers when the coach has left Watford and with an expected time of arrival back at school as we get nearer to Lichfield.

As the trip will be out all day, a packed lunch is required, as well as snacks/drinks for the day. If anyone would like a packed lunch ordering from the kitchen please let the office know via email with your order/choice of sandwich filling by 1<sup>st</sup> November at the latest please.

Children should wear their school uniform and wear appropriate coats and footwear for the weather, as some of the day will be spent outdoors. There will be an opportunity to visit the shop and/or buy a Butterbeer should you wish your child to do so. I would suggest that your child brings no more than £10 in a named purse/wallet to keep the shopping manageable - as you will be aware souvenirs are quite expensive at this venue so it may be worth checking their website before the visit, although there are some items, like pencils for a £1.
