P.E. Kits

Please ensure that your child comes to school every **Tuesday** (not children only attending for the morning) and **Friday** in their P.E. kit. They need to wear their school grey jogging bottoms, school green t-shirt and school hoodie. Please can you ensure all of these items are clearly named as every child's is identical.

Forest School

For the Summer Term we will be taking part in Forest School every Monday afternoon. Please send your child with a change of warm clothes (that you do not mind getting muddy), if they are attending for the whole day. They will also need wellies and a waterproof layer.

Please could I ask that all of these items are named, including the bag.

Themes

This half term our theme is 'Once Upon a Fairytale'. We will be reading 'The Gingerbread Man', 'The Three Little Pigs' and 'Goldilocks and the Three Bears'. We have a Three Bears cottage role play area and a The Three Little Pigs construction area outside. If you would like to share other traditional tales at home, this would link very well with our theme.



Reception Reading Books

Please ensure that you are reading at home with your child at least 4 times a week. Each time you read at home write a comment and sign their planner. They need their book and planner in school with them every day, so that they can also read at school. Books will be changed every Friday. Some children may have a printed piece of paper, a Ditty, this is their reading book.

Library Books

All children will continue to bring home a library book to share at home. These will be changed every Tuesday, please ensure that your child's book and folder are in school each week.

Reception Class

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A few reminders:

- ☺ Please can all toast/crummet/teacake money be sent into school on a Monday, for the week ahead, in a named envelope.
- ☺ Please can you ensure that **ALL** your child's belongings are named, incl. bottles, coats, everything!!
- ☺ Please can all children come to school with weather appropriate clothing. They spend a lot of time outside learning and playing throughout the day so gloves, hats etc. are essential. Then as the weather improves sun hats and sun cream.

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
