# Nursery Applications


Places will be offered on 8th March 2024.

#### **Themes**

Within the classroom we will be exploring lots of vehicles and using them to support our learning.







## Reception Reading Books

All Reception children will be bring a new reading book (Green words, paper ditty or sound mat) home every Friday. Some of the books have single words on a page to encourage children to practice their blending skills. The book is set at a level that should allow them to read it relatively confidently and independently. This is to develop enjoyment and confidence around reading. This is your child's reading homework and should be read at least 4 times at home during the week. Please ensure that each time your child reads a comment is written in their diary. You child's reading book and planner should be with them in school everyday so that they can read in school also. If you have any questions about Reading in Reception please ask a member of the Early Years staff.

<u>All children</u> will soon bring home a library book to enjoy and share at home. These will be changed every Tuesday.

## Familiar adults

As you are aware there has been a change in the EY staffing from January.
