Looking ahead:

ENGLISH	Our English lessons are split into Phonics, Reading and Writing. Our English lessons are linked to our topic and we will be thinking about artists and famous art work to inspire our writing, using books like 'Katie and the Sunflowers'.
MATHS	Year 1 are developing their place value knowledge with numbers up to 50 and Year 2 will be continuing to look at multiplication and division. We will all be looking at length and height and ways to measure this as well-tape measures at the ready!
TOPIC	Our new topic is 'Famous for More Than 5 Minutes'. Initially, we will be looking at the famous artists, Van Gogh and Picasso. We will be looking at their different styles and then creating artwork inspired by what we have learned.
SCIENCE	Our Science topic this half term is 'Growing Things' and we will put our learning to the test to see what plants need to grow. Perhaps you could try growing something at home too?
PE	In our PE lessons, we will be learning skills and techniques to help us play tennis such as accuracy, sending and receiving. We will also continue to build our teamwork skills and resilience.
RE/ PSHE	In PSHE, we are going to be thinking about ourselves and the relationships we have with others. In RE, we are thinking about families and communities as well as the Easter story.

Reading:

You may find that your child is slow or hesitant when reading. We encourage them to be fluent readers, which means not only reading at speed and recognising words by sight, but also to consider intonation and expression. A good way to practice this is with echo reading. You read it first and they copy. It builds confidence and aids in their understanding. Give it a go!
