Reception Homework

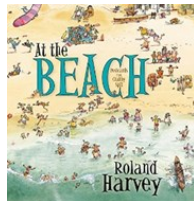
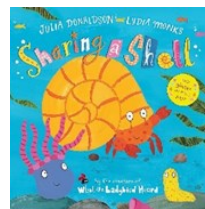
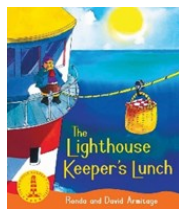
