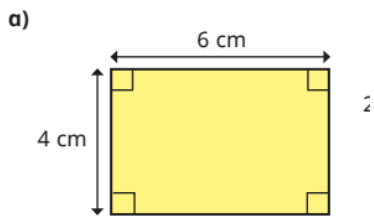


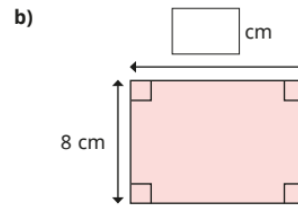

2 Work out the areas and perimeters



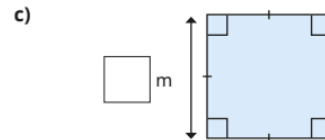
perimeter =  cm
