### Looking ahead:

ENGLISH	Our English lessons are split into Phonics, Reading and Writing. Our English lessons will focus around <i>The Pirate Cruncher</i> , by Jonny Duddle. We will be writing our own stories of a pirate's life at sea and the possible sea monsters they face!
MATHS	This term, Year 1 begin to delve in to multiplication and division and how this is linked to fractions. Year 2 will be continuing to look at this as well and then we will be thinking about time and how to read an analogue clock- a tricky concept!
TOPIC	We will be finishing our art based topic, focusing on Picasso and creating portraits inspired by his art. We are then moving on to 'Oceans and Seas' which will focus on the locations, differences, wildlife and conservation.
SCIENCE	Our Science topic this half term is 'Seasonal Changes' and we will be thinking about the different types of weather we experience throughout the year - we may even make some art to represent it.
PE	In our PE lessons, we will be developing our striking and fielding skills as well as learning skills involved in playing 'tag' rugby.
RE/ PSHE	In PSHE, we are going to be thinking about ourselves and the relationships we have with others. In RE, we are looking at important religious stories and what messages they share with the world.

### PHONICS SCREENING /SATS:

In June, **all Year 1** children will sit their Phonics Screening check. This is a set of 40 words (real and fake) which the children must read correctly. We will be practicing for the test over the coming weeks as well as sharing ways you can practice at home on class dojo.

In June, **all Year 2** children will sit SATS. The children's progress in reading and maths will be assessed at this time. If you have any questions, please contact us.
