### Looking ahead:

ENGLISH	We will be soon be finishing our Oceans and Seas topic, which has been inspired by many books that we have enjoyed, such as Dear Greenpeace, our current text. We will be moving on to The Day the Crayons Quit and some more creative writing opportunities.
MATHS	This term, Year 1 and 2 have started to think about money and are enjoying playing shop. We will be thinking about measurement as well as doing some work with statistics and creating pictograms to record our results.
TOPIC	We have started this half term with some art inspired by the oceans and will be looking at how we can create tone and texture in a wave.
SCIENCE	Our Science topic this half term is 'Wild and Wonderful' and we will be thinking about the the variety of creatures, including humans, who have adapted to their environments. We will also be looking at 'Growing Plants' across the half term and recording our findings.
PE	In our PE lessons, we will be continuing to develop our teamwork skills, preparing for the sport's day events as well as improving our accuracy when striking and fielding.
RE/ PSHE	In PSHE, we are going to be thinking about our economic wellbeing. In RE, we will be looking at Shavuot, a Jewish festival as well as celebrating and recognising other faiths.

### PHONICS SCREENING /SATS:

Next week, **all Year 1** children will sit their Phonics Screening check. This is a set of 40 words (real and fake) which the children must read correctly.

The **Year 2** children have already begun their SATS tests. The children's progress in reading and maths will be assessed at this time.
